The Hutton Wandesley Site – How to get there

From the A1 – Leave the A1 (Wetherby, Racecourse) at the sign for the B1224 (York). Take the 3rd exit at the roundabout signpost Racecourse. Next roundabout take first left B1224 York. Continue to Long Marston, turn right in the village at the sign for Hutton Wandesley. The field is signposted on the right as you leave the village.

From the East A64 – Leave the A64 at A1237 Jct. At the roundabout go toward Askham Bryam, proceed past the college entrance and take the next left. Follow signs to Askham Richard. Continue through Askham Richard and on to Angram. The site is signposted on the left 1.5 miles after Angram village.
